# Prayer Is A *Priority*

“God can and does work miracles. I celebrated my one-year anniversary of a time when the prayer of God’s people literally made the difference between life and death for me.

It all started when I had an elective surgery on October 14, 2023. What seemed very routine quickly changed. The following day, I had complications after surgery; my heart stopped, and they had to resuscitate me.

I ended up spending most of the next three weeks unconscious and on a ventilator in the ICU. Many days, doctors felt it could be my last.

Laying there, I could do nothing in my power. I needed to rely on my church family to go before the Lord in intercessory prayer on my behalf, including a visit from the elders who anointed me with oil and prayed with me. As I look back on those days, I am reminded how blessed

I am to be part of a church where Prayer Is A Priority.

The fact that I was able to return home 58 days later — 28 days in the ICU, 23 days in the hospital, 14 days in a rehab nursing home — is a testimony to the power of prayer.

I praise God for being part of a church that sees the importance of and takes an active role in lifting each other up in prayer.”

“When I came to know Jesus last year, it wasn’t an overnight transformation — it took about a year for Him to truly grab my attention. At first, I’d hear His name in passing. You could call him a ‘Jesus Freak.’ This man kept encouraging me to pray. So I did. I finally poured my heart out and everything changed. Peace filled my mind like never before. That peace led me to surrender

everything — my habits, my job, even my fears.

Now, I walk by faith, trusting His Word. He’s led me to photography, to new passions, and a life of freedom I never imagined. I’m serving the church, got plugged into a small group, and I’m even scheduled to go on a mission trip in the spring. Anything is possible with Jesus.”

At first, I wasn't sure about joining, but over time, I

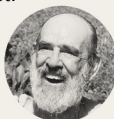
