

"God can and does work miracles. I celebrated my one-year anniversary of a time when the prayer of God's people literally made the difference between life and death for me.

It all started when I had an elective surgery on October 14, 2023. What seemed very routine quickly changed. The following day, I had complications after surgery; my heart stopped, and they had to resuscitate me.

I ended up spending most of the next three weeks unconscious and on a ventilator in the ICU. Many days, doctors felt it could be my last.

Laying there, I could do nothing in my power. I needed to rely on my church family to go before the Lord in intercessory prayer on my behalf, including a visit from the elders who anointed me with oil and prayed with me. As I look back on those days. I am reminded how blessed


I am to be part of a church where Prayer Is A Priority.

The fact that I was able to return home 58 days later — 28 days in the ICU, 23 days in the hospital, 14 days in a rehab nursing home — is a testimony to the power of prayer.


conversation with a stranger who shared how Jesus had changed his life. It was almost exactly like my prayer, and I couldn't ignore it.




